1. Terms for Martishia Romesha and Steve Smith expire on December 31, 2024.
2. Each term is for 4 years, to expire on December 31, 2028.

VOTE: Under NRS 548.285 (4 c) If the election is held by mass meeting:

1. Voting must be by secret ballot.
2. The Chair of the district supervisors shall appoint three electors present to act, without pay, as judges and tellers to count the votes at the conclusion of voting.

FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: Election results announced and accepted.
